Required Documents:

A written application addressed to the dean of the Faculty along with the following documents:

- 1-The license in any of the mentioned specializations along with the transcript.
- 2-The postgraduate diploma along with the transcript.
- 3-The master's degree.
- 4-Copy of the master's dissertation.
- 5-Birth certificate.
- 6-Police clearance certificate.
- 7-Six (6) photos 6×4.
- 8-Health certificate proving that the applicant is free of infectious diseases and disabilities that may preclude studying.
- 9-Copy of the student's passport valid for at least three years.
- 10- Written undertaking to abide by the applicable Faculty laws and regulations.

The students desirous of joining the Faculty should submit their complete files from 15/02/2021 to 30/03/2021 through the World Islamic Call Society's offices in their respective countries or the nearest country or via the following email: postgraduate@uic.edu.ly.

Second: Registration for Master's

The Faculty of Islamic Call confers the master's degree in the following specializations:

The student desirous of registering in any of the above specializations should have the license/bachelor's degree or its equivalent.

Required Documents:

A written application addressed to the dean of the Faculty along with the following documents:

- 2-Birth certificate.
- 3- Police clearance certificate.
- 4-Six (6) photos 6×4.
- 5-Health certificate proving that the applicant is free of infectious diseases and disabilities that may proclude studying.
- 6-Copy of the student's passport valid for at least three years.
- 7- Written undertaking to abide by the applicable Faculty laws and regulations.

Third: Undergraduate Departments

- 1- Department of Islamic Studies (Shariah Division Da'wa and Culture Division)
- 2- Department of Arabic language and literature
- 3- Departments of scientific specializations, including:
 - A- Financing and Banks Division
 - B- Accounting Division
 - C- IT Division
 - D- Computer Division

Conditions

- 1-The student should hold the governmental high school certificate (literary or scientific division) or equivalent from recognized religious or educational institutes with at least (Very Good) grade approved by the Ministry of Education in the respective country.
- 2- The student should have a passport valid for at least three years.
- 3-The student should not be more than 23 years.

- 4-The student should be a healthy fit as per a health certificate showing the applicant is free of infectious diseases, HIV/AIDS, pulmonary tuberculosis, and hepatitis C.
- 5- The student should not be married.

Required Documents:

- 1-A true copy of the certificate and the transcript authenticated by the Ministry of Education of the student's country.
- 2-Police clearance certificate.
- 3-Copy of the student's valid passport.
- 4-Recent birth certificate issued by the student's municipality.
- 5- A recent health certificate issued by an approved health center in his residence country dated not more than two weeks from the application date.
- 6- A nomination letter from a recognized entity in the student's country if not available in the Society's office in the country of residence.
- 7- Eight (8) photos 6×4.
- 8- Written undertaking to abide by the applicable Faculty laws and regulations.

The students desirous of joining the Faculty should submit their complete files from 15/02/2021 to 30/03/2021 through the World Islamic Call-Society's offices in their respective countries or the nearest country or via the following email: admission@uic.edu.ly.

The student shall read the undertaking and sign it along with the nominating entity.

Note:

- Priority shall be for the memorizers of the Noble Quran.
- If admitted, the student should submit the original documents; otherwise, he shall not be admitted.
- If the student fails, does not want to continue studying, is proven to be unfit, or has submitted invalid documents, he shall return to his country on his or the nominating entity's account.
- The program is for male and female students.
- The deadline for submitting the required documents is March 30, 2021.
- The submission shall be via one of the three means mentioned,
- The Faculty shall provide the student with an air ticket upon admission, after success in the first semester of the second year and after graduation. If the student books any of these on his account, he shall be reimbursed as per the exchange rate approved by the Central Bank of Libya.
- The student shall receive a monthly stipend.
- The Faculty shall provide a student hostel as part of its educational facilities.

The Faculty shall provide a restaurant for the students where they can get their meals throughout their study.

Notes on online submission:

The documents should be scanned with high quality.
The documents shall be sent in one PDF file containing all the required documents except for the photo. The photo and the PDF file shall have the name of the student. in both Arabic and English.

- The email used by the student to send the document shall be his primary contact.
